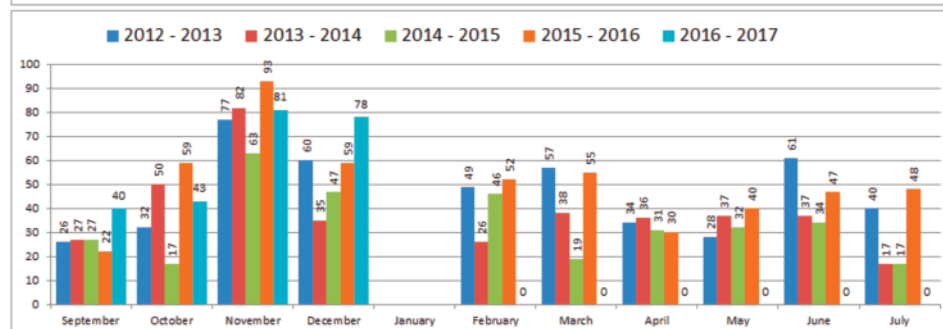

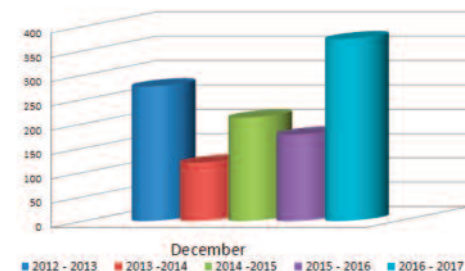

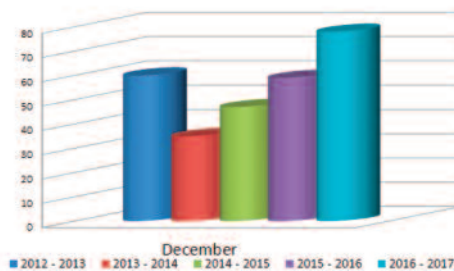
Matamata Fishing Club - Top Graph Fish Caught, Bottom Graph Number of Fisho's

Number of Members weigh in fish

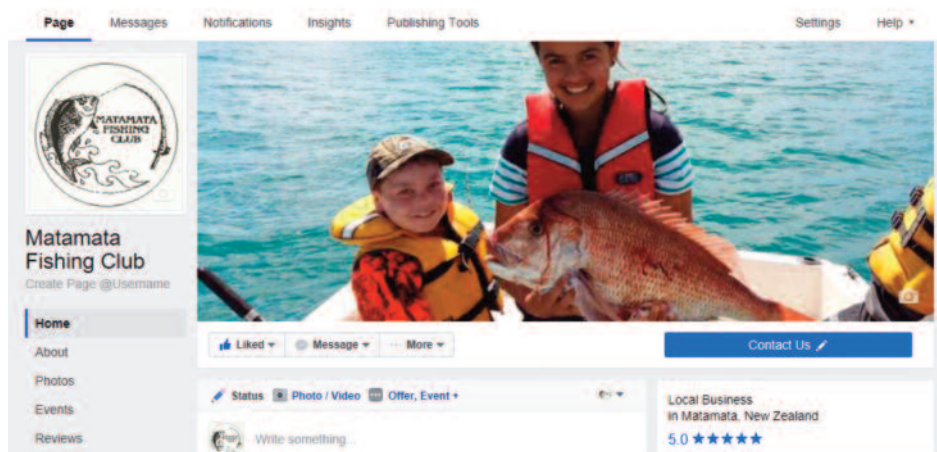
