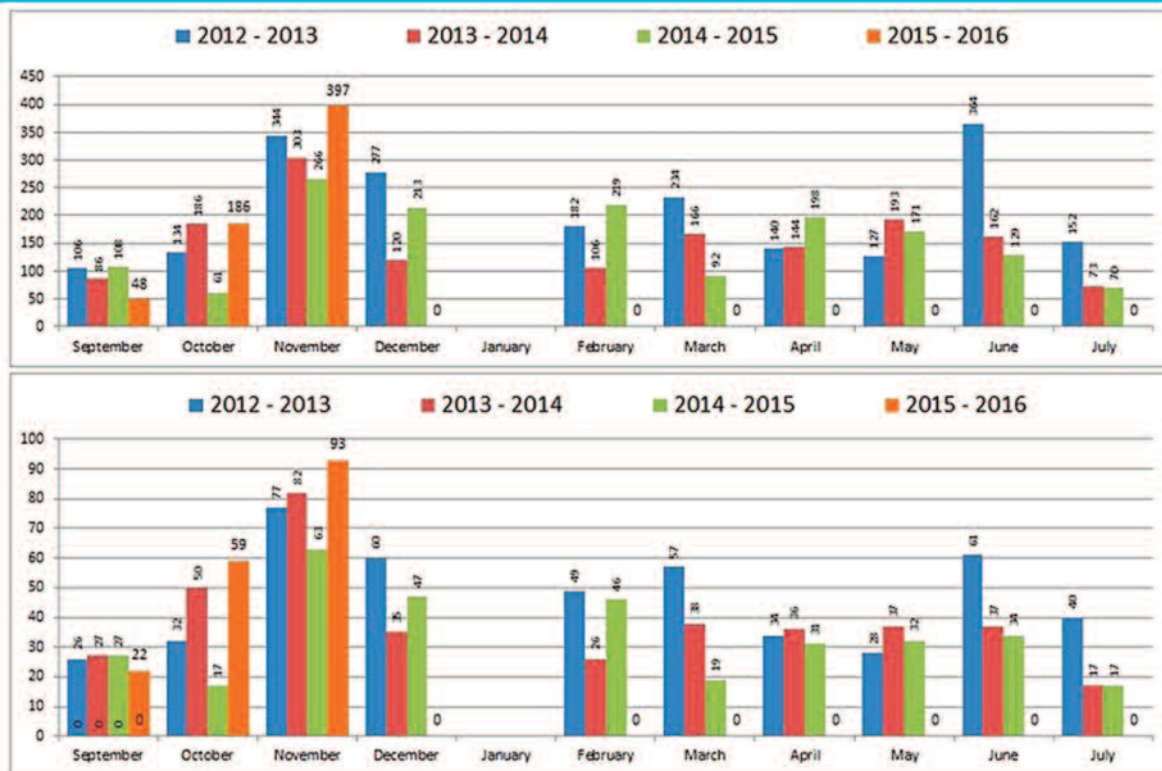

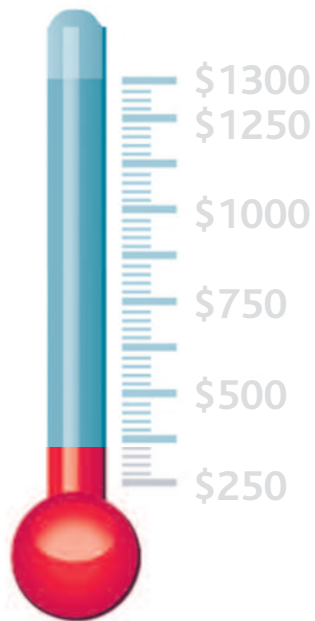


### Covered Car Trailer for Club Members to Hire
